#### Announcements:

- NMWD tank replacement (Stanton): all issues smoothed out; work projected for Feb and Mar, 2019
- Firewise community application (Stanton): delayed because fire assessment of our community needs to be done with Christie Neil, who hasn't had time
- Fire hydrant maintenance (Bennett): NMWD came out, tested all the hydrants, painted the valves red; Randy Merk has mapped all the hydrants.
- Laurel/Douglas escape route (Bennett) work to open the route has been done by Burton Eubank

### Old business:

 Road re-paving task force update (Ongerth) –Expecting the preliminary engineer's report by the end of October. Task force will meet once report is in. Road repaving timing: most likely April-Sept 2020 (after the water tank is replaced; fairly warm temperature). We need to petition for the election 81 days before the election. So election likely fall 2019. We will start work on the petition soon after Annual Meeting in January.

- PRERAB update (Ongerth): pending projects:
  - Douglas temporary realignment—the crew will be available soon to do the ditching, clean the culverts and do some grading once we get some rain.
  - Pothole repair: have 2 estimates (Lunny and Inverness Gardening Service—both about \$36,000); 2,261 sq. ft. of potholes to be repaired. Bids based on 3-inch fill; would be maybe \$1,000 less if 2-inch fill. Baywood Place especially in need as little has been done on that road. If we do a good job there now, perhaps don't have to pave it when road is paved. E. Robert also needs to be done in advance of repaving. (Especially if the paving vote fails, 3" will be good to have done.)
- 2018 Chipping update (Stanton, Ongerth)—very successful in creating good will and generating membership; 1st round, 40 piles; 2nd round, 82 piles. Removed a lot of combustible material, creating greater fire safety. Some of the clearing was done on vacant lots previously not cleared. A plus for our Firewise Marin application. Haven't yet scheduled dead and dying trees removal; could possibly do more chipping at that point. Conclusion: very successful program—do again next year. Michael willing to administer again. Finances: we paid ~\$75/pile to Inverness Gardening (people paid \$25 per pile); next time, need to clarify the pile size (we were generous this time) and raise the price so that it pays for itself. Would be helpful to have people submit a written sheet, "Here's my payment for X# piles". Randy, Julie and Mike will produce a sheet to hand out at Annual Meeting with Round 1 and Round 2 tear-offs. Include acceptable dimensions of piles.
- Trail clearing project October 20 (9 to 12:30 + lunch) (Bortel): 5 sign-ups from the Update. Sydne will give notice to Myn to send out to Google Group in the next few days. Will be clearing drainage ditches on Inverness Ridge Trail, likely from Sunnyside to DVD. 2 Park staff people will train workers, provide mosquito repellent, gloves, shovels, etc. Sydne and Kay will provide food (muffins and coffee; sandwiches).

### New business:

- November meeting (Stanton): 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday at Ongerth's, 41 Sunnyside. –
  Joint Meeting with PRERAB on fire prevention. We'll hear from Yosemite
  West folks about their experience. We could audio record the presentation
  for those who can't be there.
- Annual Meeting: January 12<sup>th</sup>. Sydne check with Barbara Jay about hosting again.
