I have just a few Update items for you this month, as follows:

FROM PRERAB:

Work will begin on October 17th on a temporary fix for the subgrade and slope failure that took place on Douglas this spring. This will involve moving the road surface away from the slide to provide safe passage around it. A more permanent fix to shore up the area and improve drainage will need to be engineered and we hope will be completed soon after this next rainy season.

IRA CHIPPING PROGRAM:

In total the summer chipping program picked up and chipped the equivalent of 140 six-hundred square foot roadside piles, a significant amount of combustible fuel. We deeply appreciate your participation in this program and contributions to making our community a safer place for all residents. However, several residents, whose piles were chipped, have not yet paid their fees. If you are one of them, please mail your payment to the IRA address below ASAP. The IRA subsidized this program by close to two-thirds of the cost. However, we need everyone to cover their share.
